Therefore, prepare your minds for action; discipline yourselves; set all your hope on the grace that Jesus Christ will bring you when He is revealed. Like obedient children, do not be conformed to the desires that you formerly had in ignorance. (1 Peter 1:13-14)

"Therefore, prepare." The time is coming when Jesus will reveal Himself again. These are words of the apostle Peter to the church in his day. He is calling the people of God to action. He is calling those who have been changed by the love and grace of God to remain faithful to the change they have experienced when they received Jesus in their hearts. They once were one way; and now they have been changed...made new through their faith in the workings of God through Jesus.

"Therefore, prepare." We live in a culture that has become anti-Bible, anti-Church and anti-Jesus. Things that we once took for granted are no longer the norm. We are being challenged by the world to reconsider the Scripture, faith and belief in God. Peter's words to the church in his day are most certainly applicable to ours as well. In a time when being Christian is more than wearing a cross on a necklace or gathering for worship on Sundays, what are we to think and do?

Lent is a season in the life of the Church when



we have the opportunity to reflect on what is essential for our lives. What matters the most to you and me? What difference does it make? When all is said and done, what will be the result of our convictions?

"Therefore, prepare" might be considered the call for the Church as we enter Lent. As we continue through the 40 day period of consideration and reflection, what is the urgent matter before us? May I offer a word?

Let's use the coming days of Lent as a time of reconsideration, resolve and rejoicing. Reconsideration, in that we consider what is of supreme importance for our lives. Resolve, to make the changes that will enhance our lives and keep us steady on our journey of faith. Maybe, there is room for learning more of God's word. Or, we might get involved in a ministry through the church. Most certainly, we can live lives that are glorifying the One who calls us to be a witness to the world. However we choose to respond to the marvelous gift of God's grace, let us always look for ways to present Christ and His love to those who He presents to us. Rejoicing in the knowledge that God is good!

Knowing that He is coming, "Therefore, prepare."
