And He was transfigured before them, ³ and His clothes became dazzling bright, such as no one on earth could brighten them. ⁴ And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus. ⁵ Then Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us set up three tents: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." ⁶ He did not know what to say, for they were terrified. ⁷Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to Him!" ⁸ Suddenly when they looked around, they saw no one with them anymore, but only Jesus.


